The Silsbee ISD (SISD) will create a partnership between our Elementary families, schools and our community. The school policy will address:

- Parents will be included in planning, review and improvement of the school parent and family engagement policy and programs.
- Timely information about parent activities, a description and explanation of the school curriculum and forms of academic assessment and expected achievement level; and

Silsbee ISD will use parent letters, district and campus website, phone calls, email, Parent Portal, REMIND, progress reports, report cards and classroom newsletters to communicate with parents. To the extent possible, parents are notified in their home language.

*Family engagement is the mutual responsibility of families, school, and communities to build relationships to support student learning and achievement and to support family well-being and the continuous learning and development of children, families and educators.
