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Meeting Notes for October 1, 2020

Accommodations

Prior to the items to be discussed on the agenda, a discussion was held concerning Special Populations and the procedures SISD students need to follow in order to get accommodations with LIT because SISD traditionally has more accommodations. It was decided that SISD students need to follow LIT procedures in order to get LIT accommodations and bring those to SISD Instructors. LIT draw up a flowchart of the procedure that the students will need to follow.

Starfish Access

SHS has submitted applications to get into Starfish to check students grades. We will be granted Starfish access which will allow us the ability to monitor grades of our students, both ECHS and Dual Credit. LIT has a new person in charge of this and she will be back in the office next week. We can expect access soon.

LIT report for Student Performance from Spring 2020

Luke will attend ARGOS training next week . ARGOS will provide cohort data that will help us determine what courses the kids still need to take to be on track to obtain their AA.

Graduation degree audits

Degree Works, another computer program, is available to provide a degree check for our kids. We will check this year's graduating class in October. In the future, we will check every cohort at the end of every spring semester. This will allow a 2 week window to enroll a student in summer school if needed. We can also request a report for an individual student in October if necessary.

Cohort 2020 Graduates walking at LIT graduation

Graduation is set for December 11. We will contact our students to see who will be able to attend the ceremony and contact Miranda so that she will have a count. We will then proceed with the application that will give an official count and get their names in the graduation program. This application is due November 12, 2020.

Current Crosswalk Offerings and Proposed Crosswalk

Discussion was held concerning realigning the English components of our crosswalks and the possibility of moving the History courses to the sophomore year of our crosswalk. Moving the History component would gradually build the amount of college classes the kids take (7/12/18/23) as opposed to our current plan (4/6/21/29.) We are trying to maintain the structure of our crosswalk while providing flexibility. If we have the option of Philosophy instead of Math 1342 only, that will help the students weak in Math. Keeping the Math 1342 will help the kids planning to attend college and major in something like Nursing or Education. If students are planning to major in something more scientific, they would have the option to take Math 1314 and 1342 their junior year and then they could take PreCal or Calculus their senior year.

Developmental Math Student's Spring Schedule

We have 2 students that need an option for Spring in order to obtain 60 for their AA. They are currently in Developmental Math. It was decided that Philosophy may be a viable option as 2 Math courses are not required to obtain the AA.

Cohort Status Report

Everyone is currently on track. Juniors need math TSI testing. Due to Covid, no TSI testing was held in the spring.

We are looking at options for the spring semester because we may not continue with the face to face option that we currently have.
