







Meeting Notes for December 3, 2020

New Business: Several students, both ECHS and DL, have concerns with the Govt. 2305. Dr. Sizemore is aware of these concerns as some of our students have emailed her. She was phoned in to the meeting in order to further discuss them. LIT will make sure that our students are not penalized. Dr. Sizemore has a plan for moving forward. In the future, if we have problems with any instructors, please contact Dr. Sizemore as soon as possible.

Items of Discussion:

Graduation for Cohort 2020, December 11, 2020, will be virtual rather than in person as previously stated. We will notify the kids and have them send a headshot in their cap and gown to Luke and he will send the photos to the appropriate people at LIT.

LIT Report for Student Performance from Spring 2020: LIT does not have this information available yet. They are more focused on the CTE report.

Graduation degree audit for seniors: We would like one now for the seniors. Luke is passing this off to Ms. Sizemore. He and Homero will take care of the juniors.

Summer TSI bootcamp: Dr. Sizemore is in the process of developing a TSI bootcamp to prepare the kids to take and pass the TSI. It would be a 4-6 week course with a one time cost of \$150-\$200 offered Summer I and Summer II. It would be interactive, intensive and interesting, elevating the understanding of the material, both Math and English, focusing on skills, not grades. The goal would be to get TSI exemption by passing the class for which they took the boot camp.

Spring Semester:

R. Celeste and J. C. Rawls should be on our campus in the spring. LIT would like for us to send rosters of those classes before the Christmas break.

LIT is going to develop Blackboard family courses for instructors who teach the same course with the same materials. This will alleviate problems if kids shifting periods.

Our partnership with LIT was finalized and submitted to TEA although we still don't have a TEA ECHS coach. We should have one this month.
