New Business: No new business

Items of Discussion

Government 2306 Robert Wilson application. He is excited to be here and the kids seem excited to have him. If he hits the LIT objectives, he doesn't have to follow blackboard 100%

On Campus professors Spring 2021: Clinton Rawls and Renee Celeste will be on SHS campus MWF for 2nd and 3rd period with Ms. Celeste remaining thru Stripes. Cheylyn Brown is now an LIT instructor and will also report to SHS on MWF..

LIT report for Student Performance from Spring 2020 and Degree Audits for juniors and seniors: The performance reports are not formatted the way that LIT would like and the Degree Works, the program that runs the degree audits is messed up so LIT is way behind schedule getting that information out.

Grade Report vs Starfish: Starfish grades are not necessarily accurate which is why there was discrepancy between Starfish grades and the grades LIT sent in the blackboard report. There was still a discrepancy with what the teacher entered and what was reported. Blackboard is supposed to be more accurate. Get grades from our people at the end of the semester.

New TSIA2: There is a new TSI with a different scoring. Reading and Writing are now combined into one test.

ECHS students taking Dual Credit Electives (ie. welding): This is fine as long as the students are choosing ACGM electives and not technical electives. Students will pay for technical electives on their own.

Three Additional Pathways: Students could get an associate degree thru ECHS and continue with the 2x2 program that has been established thru Lamar. We could also offer a pathway for nursing, early childhood education, and business.

Cohort 2025: We are well into the recruiting process. Applications are due Feb. 19, 2021. We will develop crosswalks for the other possible pathways (CJ, business, teaching) in addition to the AA so that the students can physically see their plan and the courses required.
