LIT Partnership Meeting February 11, 2021

New Business: No new business

Items of Discussion: *Government 2306* Robert Wilson's application looks good.

LIT report for Student Performance from Spring 2020: We do not have Student Performance from Spring 2020.

Graduation Degree Audits for Juniors and Seniors: We have 18 seniors on track to graduate with their AA in the Spring. By running this degree audit, LIT is creating their "need to apply" status but we will need to be sure to submit correct spelling of their names for their degree. There is a graduation fee of \$25. We need to check on who pays for this and if it was required last year. We also need to make sure students have a black graduation gown. LIT will provide the honor cords. Luke said that they would email degree audits to us when they got back to campus. We also discussed our PTAC students. We need to make sure that schedules next year allow them to attend LIT as the classes they need next year are not online.

SHS ECHS student vs LIT student data: This is still not available.

Cohort 2025: We are well into the recruiting process. So far we have 45 applications. The deadline closes February 19, 2021. We will develop crosswalks for the other possible pathways (CJ, business, and teaching) in addition to the AA so that the students can physically see their plan and the courses required.

New Pathways: Mrs. Tacker has been in contact with LIT about qualifications for Teaching Pathway. We can change the name of Principles of Education and Training to something else because that is what SHS calls the class students take their freshman year. TEKS will be covered so it should not be a problem. Accounting has a prerequisite but it is the Math TSI. If students don't pass the math TSI, there is a developmental class that can be completed, similar to the developmental class for Math 1314.
